

Registration Deadline

If you decide that you would like to attend the program, please mail or fax the enclosed Registration Form and signed Parental Permission Statement by April 12, 2005. For your convenience, you may also register on-line at www.spelman.edu. Spelman hostesses are assigned on a “first-come, first-served basis”. You will be contacted by phone or email to confirm your attendance.

Lodging And Meals

On-campus housing and meals are available for registered students and will be arranged as part of the program. We are happy to assist parents and guardians with finding off-campus accommodations. Please see the enclosed “Places to Stay” list for nearby hotels. (This list has been provided as a service only and should not be considered an endorsement and the rates listed are not guaranteed.) Guest meals are available in the Spelman College Alma Upshaw Dining Hall at \$5.00 per person, per meal. You may purchase meal tickets at *Spel-Bound* Registration, or you may pay in cash at the door.

Transportation

Spelman will not be able to provide transportation from the airport, bus, or train stations. A taxi for one person from the airport will cost approximately \$25.00. A taxi from the West End MARTA station to campus will cost about \$5.

Parking

Parking is available on campus **Sunday** and **Monday** in the Spelman parking deck at \$3.00 per day. When you arrive, please let the guard know that you are here for Spel-Bound and they will direct you accordingly.

What To Bring

You will need a sleeping bag, casual clothes, personal items, money for transportation to and from campus, and your medical insurance card.

Other Details

We cannot provide accommodations for early arrivals or late departures, so you should plan your arrival and departure accordingly.

Rules & Regulations for Visitors

It is essential that campus visitors become familiar and comply with the following Spelman College rules and regulations.

1. Any student under 18 years of age must have a signed Parental Permission Statement on file before she can register for the program.
2. Students are expected to attend all scheduled campus visitation activities.
3. Students must comply with the directions of the Admission staff, the Resident Directors, Resident Assistants, and other college officials (including Spelman College Public Safety Officers) acting in the performance of their duties.
4. Visiting students must be signed in at the residence halls by the Resident Directors (or Resident Assistants) and their hostess.
5. Residence Hall doors are locked 24 hours a day and the doors must not be left unlocked or open.
6. Visiting students are expected to remain in their assigned residence halls between midnight and 7:00 a.m.
7. Visiting students may not entertain guests in the residence hall rooms.
8. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited on the Spelman College campus.
9. Spelman College is a smoke-free facility. Smoking in any building is prohibited.
10. Students are subject to all federal, state, and local laws and are accountable to federal, state, and city courts for any violation of such laws.
11. Spelman College will be able to supervise only those activities that are directly sponsored by Spelman College and held on campus.
12. Spelman College officials reserve the right to call parents/guardians and send students home for serious infractions or inappropriate behavior.

Directions to Spelman College

From I-75/85

Take I-20 West and exit at Lee Street. Turn right on Lee Street and continue through the next traffic light (Westview Drive). You will see a large parking lot on the right-hand side. Turn right into the second driveway. Drive one block through the parking lot and you will approach the side gate of Spelman College.

From Downtown

Take Peachtree Street to M.L. King, Jr. Drive. Turn right on M.L. King, Jr. Drive. Continue to Northside Drive. Turn left onto Northside Drive. Continue through the next three lights (passing Burger King on the right) to the fourth traffic light. Turn right onto Greensferry Avenue. Continue on Greensferry through the stop sign. Turn left at the front gate of Spelman College.

From I-20 West

Exit at Lowery Boulevard. Cross Lowery Boulevard and continue on Oak Street to the next traffic light. Turn left on Lee Street and cross the bridge over I-20 and continue through the next two traffic lights. You will see a large parking lot on the right-hand side. Turn right into the second driveway. Drive one block through the parking lot and you will approach the side gate of Spelman College.

From I-20 East

Exit at Lee Street. Turn right on Lee Street and continue through the next traffic light (Westview Drive). You will see a large parking lot on the right-hand side. Turn right into the second driveway. Drive one block through the parking lot and you will approach the side gate of Spelman College.

From Marta

From Atlanta's Hartsfield-Jackson Airport, take the Northbound MARTA train five stops to the West End station. One-way MARTA fare is \$1.75 per person. Outside of the station, taxis are available to drive approximately three blocks to Spelman College. Estimated taxi fare is \$5.00.

However if medical attention is needed, Health Services will facilitate any medical services required in case of accident or injury, and I will not hold the college responsible. I do, however, give permission for my daughter to be transported via ambulance and treated by licensed medical professionals on an emergency basis if necessary.
