SELECTION CRITERIA AND REQUIREMENTS:

- Sophomore classification
- Cumulative GPA 3.6+
- Demonstrate genuine interest in Rochester
- 2 BCPM, 1 non-BCPM Letters of Recommendation
- Approximately 60 credits left to complete Spelman degree
- Gain relevant experience (clinical, enrichment, or research)
