The 2025 Annual Campus Security and Fire Report required by the U.S. Department of Education, which must be published by October 1, 2025, is now available.

You can also access this report from the [Public Safety](#) Quick Link on the Spelman home page. Hard copies of the report are available on request during regular business hours, 9:00 am - 5:00 pm M-F in the Public Safety office.

This report contains important information about campus safety and security services and programs. Among the topics addressed are College policies related to sexual assaults, alcohol, hazing, and drugs, emergency response, and notifications of missing resident students, fire safety, statistics for the past three calendar years regarding many types of criminal acts, and fire incidents on the campus.

Another important resource available to you on the [Public Safety website](#) is the Daily Crime and Fire Log, which lists all crimes and residential fire incidents reported to the Public Safety Department and provides incident location and follow-up status.
