



## Route Tracing via Google Maps

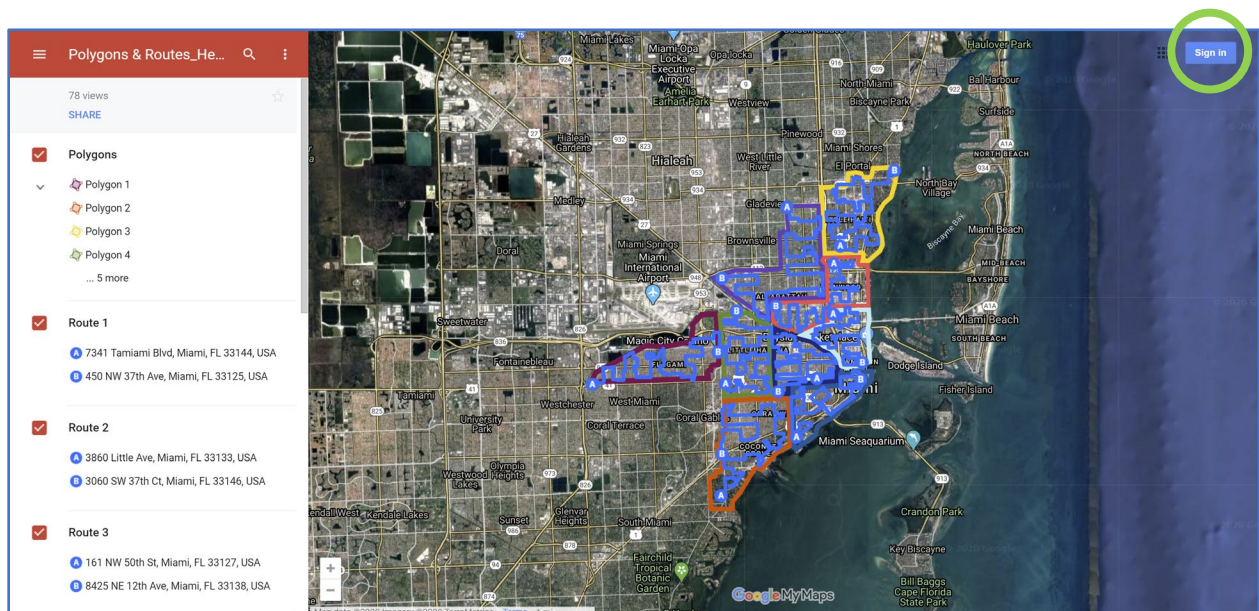
Heat Watch campaign navigators can use Google Maps to trace their GPS position over their route by following the below instructions. Note that this only allows *tracing* of your position along your route, and that you will still need to carefully follow the provided step-by-step directions.

### Requirements

- Google account (free)
- Internet-enabled mobile device
- Google Maps app (free)

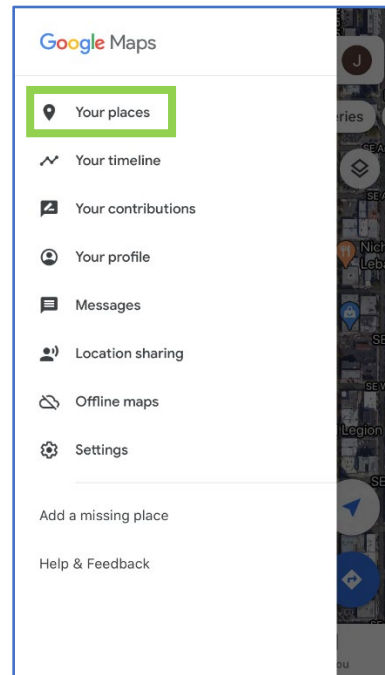
Instructions: Follow the written steps and visual cues in **lime green**.

1. Visit your Polygons & Routes map on any device, and sign in to your Google account in the top-right corner.

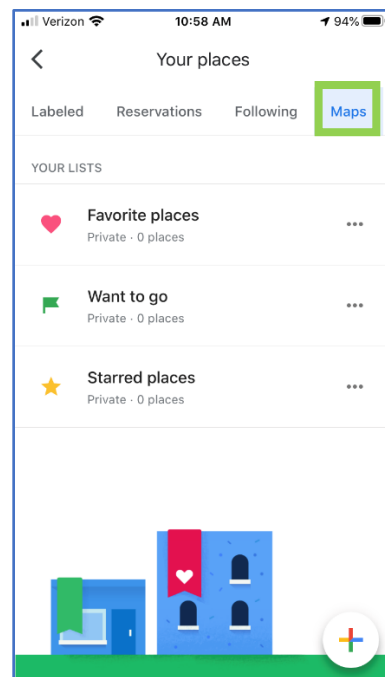




2. On your **mobile device**, open the Google Maps app on your phone and select the three horizontal bars in the top-left to open the side bar. Then select **Your Places**.

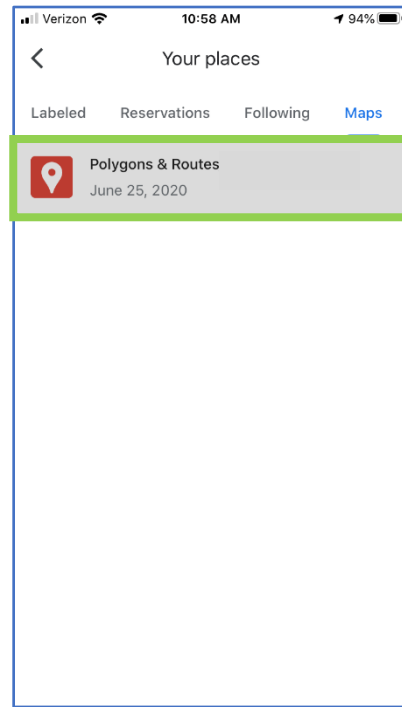


3. Scroll along the top bar to the right (swipe left) to **Maps**.





4. Select your **polygon map**.



5. You can now pinch & zoom into your route, and if you are within the area, you should see your **live GPS position** as a blue dot.

You may need to zoom in/out or refresh the map (repeating steps 2-4) to find your route.

Click "VIEW MAP LEGEND" to deselect other routes and polygons. Then click the back arrow (not "X CLOSE") to return to your map.
