

**Notice to Premedical Advisors**

In response to concerns about the effects of the pandemic on applicants, we are writing to inform you of a few recent updates to IU School of Medicine's admissions criteria. Please review the information below and share accordingly. **Admission criteria updates for students applying to IU School of Medicine.**

- The school plans to maintain its existing practice of accepting P/NP (no pass) or S/F grades as meeting requirements, which includes exercising flexibility in accepting additional S/F grades for the spring and possibly summer terms.
- Students are encouraged to consider deferring enrollment in the science prerequisites until the next academic term when letter grades are reinstated. Students who wish to appeal for a letter grade rather than (S/F or P/NP) may do so at their discretion.
- Online coursework is accepted but preference is for students to complete science prerequisite courses in classroom settings, when available.
- Holistic review assessments will remain in place to determine the fitness of applicants' backgrounds for medical school admission.
