

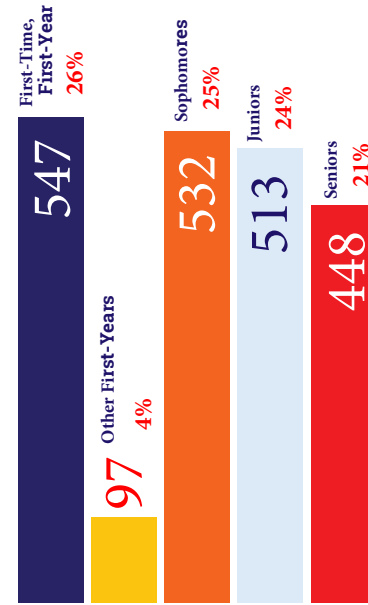

## ABOUT

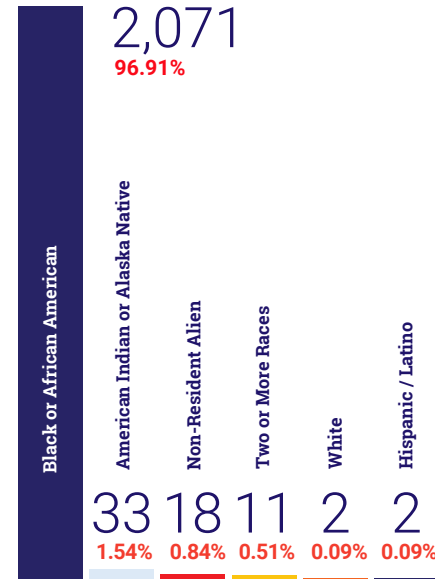

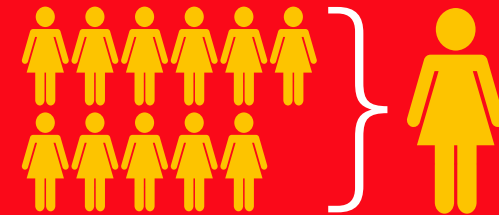

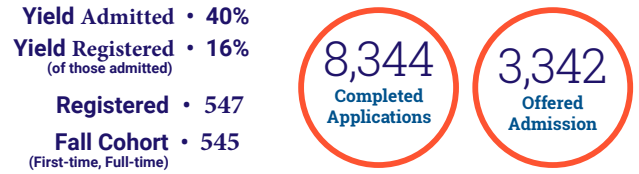

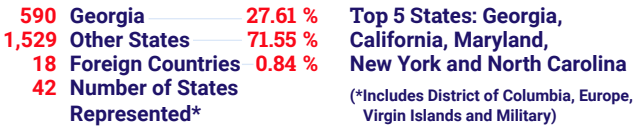
## first-time, first year PROFILE

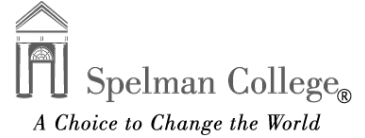
